While she was pregnant with Zane (2 years ago) she a wisdom tooth had extracted, which they had to break into pieces and remove without anesthesia. As you can imagine, this was quite traumatic and she has had problems with the neighboring tooth ever since.

Recently, a trip to

the dentist revealed the need for a root canal in that tooth. The morning after the procedure she awoke in severe pain with something protruding from her gums behind the tooth. We returned to the dentist where they removed a large piece of jaw bone (which I kept as a trophy, but Lisa wouldn't let me include a picture of it). It had evidently broken loose due to infection in the bone!

While I thought it was all a little weird, the dentist acted as if it were quite routine. The good news is that the root canal, removal of the broken bone, and treatment for the infection has her feeling much better
