Indian Meeting Ends

Our meeting with Indian medical the students ended in Mav. Most of them return to India for the summer and we will resume our Bible Study in the Fall. We ended the year by showing an evangelistic film to the Hindu student mostly population. My partner, Ken and I also spoke to them for about an hour about Sin & Salvation. I was not sure how they would react, but many of them came up afterwards and told us how interesting our talk was. The believing students who hosted the event said that the response was very positive. For several days afterwards thev had unbelieving students asking when we would be having another event for them to attend. Praise God that we were able to share the gospel clearly and have an open door to do it again next year.

A Young Life Ends

A young man that was part of our children's meeting about 9 years ago was recently killed in a street fight. Oleg (highlighted in photo) came to our youth meetings briefly when he was a boy. After he



stopped attending youth meetings we lost track of him. I was sad to find out a few years ago that he was terrorizing our old neighborhood as part of a skin-head gang. A few weeks ago he attacked a darkskinned Armenian guy and was stabbed to death by the guy's older brother. The skinhead gang threatened retaliation and our Armenian friends from that area ended up staying with us for a few days while things cooled off. Please pray that this would cause many to think about eternity and their need for Jesus.

Are You Ready for the End?

When doing street evangelism, we like to ask people what they think will happen after they die. Sometimes we assume that people do not want to talk about death when, in fact, it is exactly what is on their minds and many are anxious to discuss it. If we will just open our mouths then God will open hearts.

Not long ago, a friend of ours named Kostya, who

shares they gospel with college students, told us of an interesting encounter. He approached some girls and asked them if they had ever thought about what happens to the soul after death. One girl said that she had recently been thinking about it a lot after reading a small booklet that someone had given her When she on the street. showed it to Kostya it turned out to be one of the tracts that we had printed and handed out in our area. God used it to enable Kostya to have a long conversation with those girls about eternity!
