Many of the tracts we have handed out in the past have ended up littering the sidewalk as people take them and quickly toss them to the ground. **Not only do people take this tract and read it, they keep it and even ask us for extras to give their friends!** That's never happened before.

have been reluctant to share their faith in the past are now eager to give this tract out to their friends. Some have even just left them lying around in public places where they are quickly snatched up by passers by. Please pray that we would quickly distribute the 20,000 tracts we had printed and begin printing more.
