GO FEST: As a base, we kicked off this month in Pachuca, Mexico celebrating our annual Go Fest where people from different bases all over Mexico come to connect and see what God is doing all over the country. It was so great to see some of my friends from other bases and meet a lot of new people as well! We really focused on Mexico City and shared our vision to start a base there. Then, that Thursday, we all took the 2 hr. bus ride down to Mexico City and did some evangelism. We split up into 3 ministry groups—street kids, prostitution, and Tepito (one of the most dangerous parts of Mexico City). I went with the prostitution ministry. We bought roses and gave them out to the prostitutes. God really challenged me to ask Him for specific words for each girl we talked to and then tell them those things. It was amazing to see God touch so many of their lives through our words of truth and love! Overall, the whole week was incredible!

BLS (Basic Leadership School): It has been soooo great being in this leadership school so far. God is teaching me so much about what a true leader is and how He has created me to lead. He has also put me in so many situations this month where I could apply the things I had been learning in class. God has really been speaking to me about seeing the best and the potential in people and then calling that out in them. That means having relationship with them and encouraging them in the calling God has put on their lives. I have never gotten so close to the DTS students in general before and it is really encouraging for me to see how God can and is using my life to bless and disciple them.

HAITI: I absolutely love my outreach team!!! We have 8 students and then Manny and I are leading the team. We leave for Haiti on the 22nd of this month and everyone is starting to get more excited about it! A few months ago, 3 hurricanes hit Haiti in the matter of about a week, so there is a lot of damage and relief work needed. We will be going to 4 or 5 different YWAM bases over the 2 months that we will be there to help them get back on their feet and, of course, to spread the hope of Jesus Christ with the Haitian people! One of the coolest things in all of this is that Manny is from Haiti, so he speaks the language and we will be able to meet his family—what a blessing!!!
