Usually in this time pastors either send their youth away or encourage them to stay at home to protect them. However, this year we reached out to the local Christian youth and put on a mini missions-to-your-city camp. We invited pastors to send their youth to us so we could teach

As a base, we have been praying a lot into this issue and have felt like God is just asking us to pray for this nation and its people, to pray for the church to rise up and fight for their country, to pray against fear and
