**ALFREDO:** In the beginning of this month, a man, Alfredo, from one of the local churches in Mazatlán, was involved in a serious accident and died. He was well known in the city and in several churches, and through his death God started something He brought several key churches together that have had problems in the past with each other. I heard that there were more than 5 different churches represented at his wake; the pastor from another church gave the message at his funeral; over 1000 people came through the church in those two days. Now I don't know if any of that sounds extraordinary to you, but those are all HUGE breakthroughs for the body of Christ in Mazatlán. And this movement, or whatever you want to call it, didn't end there. His pastor, after his death, decided to bring the church into a 40 day period of fasting and interceding for Mazatlán and Mexico. I wish that I could be there to see more of what God is doing through this man's death, but I know that incredible things are happening and changing.

STAFF RETREAT and FINANCE SEMI-NAR: The base started off this month with our annual staff retreat. For the weekend, I helped co-lead our worship times and translate. We had a lady from Costa Rica come to speak to all of our staff about Intimacy with Christ and it was an awesome four days!! God was really speaking to me, both in my personal quiet times and through the speaker, about stepping out in leading worship (especially in Spanish) and about going a step deeper in relationship with Him. Overall, it was a really refreshing weekend and we were all very blessed! Right after we got back from that, we had the base director of YWAM El Paso/Juarez come and speak to us about finances. We looked at budgets and how to manage our money and a lot of practical stuff. But my favorite part was when we looked at the Bible and looked up different passages about money. It amazed me to see deeper into God's perspective on money and how to look at it, have it and spend it.
