season of rest and preparation. One thing that I have realized over these past 2 months at home is that I don't really know what it means to rest in Christ and let Him refresh me. A few things that I DID do this month include leading worship and sharing about my past year of ministry at my home church, being in my best friend from high school, Mari's, wedding, and going on a family vacation with my family to Guatemala! My whole family hadn't gone on vacation for about 4 years (since I was in high school) and my mom knows a missionary family down there, so we headed off for 10 days! So far we have climbed a volcano, gone on a boat tour of several small villages around Lake Atitlan learning about their cultures, fed kids as part of their Mana feeding program, played with the kids in their children's home, visited a local video and audio ministry, Viña, focused on reaching indigenous groups, and gone to the local marketplace. It has been a really good time of hanging out as a family and learning about the local culture!
